## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Pesguard® CT2.6 is a feeding and contact insecticide with excellent efficacy against adult flies. It is designed for application by painting or spraying and is used to control Dipteran flies in barns and other animal housing. It should be applied to walls, poles, window sills and other preferred resting places for adult flies, with treatment commencing with first observation of flies in the premises. For best effect the product should be applied to many small areas, evenly distributed throughout the barn. The product should be reapplied at 6-8 week intervals or when necessary.

Animals may remain in the premises while treatment is carried out, but ensure that they cannot reach or lick the treated areas.

Under some circumstances the treatment can cause slight discolouration of the treated surface.

## APPLICATION AND DOSAGE

500ml of Pesguard® CT2.6 treats an area of 200m<sup>2</sup>.

### 1. Application by painting

The product should be applied undiluted using a brush to clean, non-absorbent surfaces. It should be applied to strips approximately 10 x 30cm on walls, boxes, doors, window frames etc close to but outside the reach of animals. If no such suitable places are available for application then the product can be applied to pieces of cardboard, 20 x 15cm (A5) hung in the premises close to but out of the reach of the animals.

### 2. Application by spraying

500ml of Pesguard® CT2.6 should be diluted with 1L of water and applied using low-pressure spraying equipment (e.g. backpack sprayer) to walls, boxes, doors, window frames and other places where flies can be seen resting. The product should be applied close to, but out of the reach of, the animals. If no such suitable places are available for application then the product can be applied to pieces of cardboard, 20 x 15cm (A5) hung in the premises close to but out of the reach of the animals.

The diluted material should be used immediately and not stored. Only dilute the quantity that is needed for immediate use.
